## SHORELINE PROTECTION & REHABILITATION COMMITTEE

November 20, 2003

### DRAFT MEETING NOTES

The meeting in the Twin Lakes Village Hall was called to order at 7:10 pm by leader, Judy Jooss. Since a quorum was present the meeting proceeded. Andy Hryniewicz volunteered to act as secretary for this meeting.

Committee Present: Judy Jooss, Charles Hass., Andrew Hryniewicz, Gloria Laurin, Michael Lux, Debbie Sarna.

Commissioner: Jeff Gresenz; Others: Jerry Wrench, George Sobotka.

The agenda was approved without changes.

**Motion by Debbie Sarna, seconded by Michael Lux to approve the notes of September 18th meeting. Approved unanimously.**

**Motion made by [REDACTED], seconded by [REDACTED] to accept notes of October meeting (not formal meeting). Notes were accepted unanimously.**

**Motion by [REDACTED], seconded by [REDACTED] to approve the committee goals and objectives as follows. Approved unanimously.**

- Protect the remaining natural shorelines of Lakes Mary & Elizabeth;
- Help manage the lake levels to protect our shorelines (the village has the ultimate control of this);
- Encourage the restoration of natural vegetation (shoreline gardens) on all shorelines;
- Conduct workshops for citizens to learn good shoreline stewardship practices;
- Supply the communications committee with material to distribute to the community;
- Design and construct some example restoration projects; highlight existing good shoreline practices;
- Advise the Village of Twin Lakes on ordinances necessary to protect the shorelines (and consequently the water quality and property values) of Lakes Mary & Elizabeth.

On October 3<sup>rd</sup>, in preparation for selecting projects, the committee toured 5 of the potential project sites. Tour attendees were Judy Jooss, Andy Hryniewicz, Wayne Kimmell, Michael Lux, Debbie Sarna and J.D. [REDACTED].

The committee reviewed the complete project package that was presented to the Steering Council on November 6<sup>th</sup> and the Twin Lakes Protection and Rehabilitation District Commissioners on November 17<sup>th</sup>. Shoreline protection projects were discussed and decision was made to focus on four as approved by the Twin Lakes Protection and Rehabilitation District Commissioners:

- Project 1, South Lake Ave. (Village) (Project #1 on list of November 6, 03) It was decided that this is going to be our first project. Plan is to get a landscape plant design for the location. Judy Jooss will talk to Rob Weimer and Bob Livingston for ideas. Jerry Wrench suggested a "pill box" of sorts to be installed by the storm pipe to purify the water before it enters the lake. Jerry will check with Tom Porps and Bob Livingston for suggestions. Debbie will talk with Lorrie Schory (artist) to design a sign to be placed on the site. Plea for donations to cover the costs will be part of the sign. **Mike Lux motioned to do this, Charlie Hass seconded the motion. Motion was approved unanimously.**

Wrench – will research stormwater aspects of site

- Project 2, Lakeview channel (Village) (Project #6 on list of November 6, 03) There are four sites on Lake Elizabeth channel. The first one we are going to beautify will be the one that is on the South side of the channel and close to the entrance to the lake. We will do a site evaluation, do a landscape and plant design. Also we will design a sign and place it on the location. Garden Club will be called for help. **Gloria Laurin motioned to do this, Mike Lux second the motion. Motion was approved unanimously.**

- Project 3, Lance Park (Village) (Project #3 on list of November 6, 03) We were asked to get involved in beautifying Lance Park. We will do site design suggestions for the beach, the launch, and the Aquanut site. **Mike Lux motioned to do this, Charlie Hass seconded the motion. Motion was approved unanimously.**

Note: The Lake District Commissioners approved projects 1-3 with the request that we try to get some youth involvement. Charlie Hass will go to the Communications Committee to ask for their cooperation in getting youth involved as part of their education mission.

- Project 4, Bayview channel project (Homeowner Association) (Project #4 on list of November 6, 03) This major long term project of wetland and bank stabilization, storm water control at two existing locations and sensibly dredging the channel so no existing home on either side of the channel would be endangered. Andy Hryniewicz will be meeting with Kathy Aaron (a free lance consultant) on Dec. 3, 9:00 am at his house. They will come up with one plan that Andy will present to the Committee. Andy also will get in contact with Applied Ecological Services (aes.com) to find out what they have done for other communities which had similar problems. Jerry Wrench and Tony Fisher may join Andy on Dec. 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Assignments:

Hryniewicz – meet with consultant Aron & Assoc; contact AES about project  
 Wrench – continue to design a comprehensive stormwater mgmnt plan for watershed affecting this site.

Discussion of Agenda Item 9, Other Possible Projects (see agenda for list), was postponed to a future meeting due to lack of time.

All committee members in attendance gave permission to post their names, phone numbers & email addresses on website.
